AVENUE ROAD 1. 5245 (South Side) Main building to Great Malvern Station (formerly listed as Great Malvern Station) SO 74 NE 12/29 12.9.69. II GV 2. 1861-2, by E W Elmslie. Long, low, single-storey building in Gothic style. Granite rubble, freestone dressings and features; hipped slate roof, several paired polygonal stone stacks with caps. Various windows, some with triangular heads and trefoiled plate tracery. Elliptical-arched door openings, some with stilted arches and shafts in spandrels with foliated capitals. Wing at the north end has 3 coped gables. Wing at the south end has 2 gables and carriage entry. Glazed canopy over platform has girderwork on ornamental cast-iron brackets and thin, round, cast-iron columns with foliated capitals.
