I have the honour to report for the information of the Board of Trade, that in compliance with the instructions contained in your Minute of the 25th June I have inspected for Colonel Gorton the new works at Maiden Wells on the Great Western Railway.

At this station a new cross-over road has been provided between the Up and Down Main lines at the Up end of the Station.

The points are worked from the existing Station Signal Box, which contains a frame of 21 levers, all of which are in use.

The only requirement noted was that on account of the distance of the new cross-over road from the Signal Box disc signals are required at it; these the Company has agreed to supply.

Subject to the fulfilment of this requirement, the completion of which should be reported, I can recommend the Board of Trade to sanction the works being brought into use.
